Accreditation

Delta College is a community college that awards both Associate Degrees and Certificates in transfer and occupational areas. Delta College is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission of the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools. The College is an "A" rating in the "Report of Credit Given" of the American Association of Collegiate Registrars and Admissions Officers. Delta College is a member of the MACRAO Statewide Transfer Agreement (MACRAO) and the Michigan Transfer Agreement (MTA—effective Fall 2014). Students who have met the requirements for either agreement will have appropriate designation on the transcript.

College Calendar

Delta College operates on the trimester system with three 15-week semesters yearly. Credit hours on transcripts are semester hours.

Advance Transfer Credit

Transfer credits awarded appear on the transcript, but are not included in the computation of the grade point average. Courses with grades of C or above at 100 or 200 level are considered for transfer equivalency credit.

Repeated Courses

Repeated Courses are indicated on the transcript by using the letter R next to the grade column. The best grade is used in computing the grade point average.

Pass/No Credit System

The pass/no credit system is used only for courses specifically approved by the various academic divisions of the college. "P" (Pass) credit is granted and represents performance at or above the "C" (2.0) level. "NC" (No Credit) means no credit is granted and represents performance at or below "C-" (1.7) level.

Below 100 Level Coursework

Courses below 100 level are not utilized towards fulfillment of graduation requirements.

TonerSecure bonds paper and toner and attempts to remove printed images will damage the paper surface, revealing the alteration. It also contains an artificial watermark on the back which can be seen by holding the sheet at an angle where you can see a stamp mark image of VoidSecure®. This artificial watermark can also be validated by rubbing the edge of a coin along the back of the sheet for the image to appear.
